Also, at its October 16, 2020, meeting, the AAUW National Board of Directors voted to increase National Individual Member dues for the next three years. The dues will rise by \$3 for Fiscal Year (FY) 2022, \$5 for FY 2023 and \$5 for FY 2024, making the total dues amount to National for those years \$62, \$67 and \$72, respectively. All but \$3 of your annual dues remains tax deductible. Dues to California and Fallbrook Chapter are TBD, but probably will remain unchanged.


