## **AAUW National News**

### AAUW ELECTION RESULTS: MEMBERS HAVE SPOKEN

Many thanks to everyone who voted in <u>AAUW's 2021 National Election</u>. It took a mere three days to reach the required quorum—a testament to our members' passion and engagement.

Julia Brown and Malinda Gaul were re-elected as board chair and vice chair, respectively, and Elizabeth Haynes and Joseph Bertolino will retain their board seats.

AAUW's public policy priorities were approved by 92% of voters. The board-recommended ballot initiative to remove the college-degree membership requirement did not receive the two-thirds vote required to enact a bylaw change. However, a remarkable 63% of you voted in favor of this change, indicating a momentum shift toward a more inclusive membership.

While we have many voices, all AAUW members share a commitment to advancing gender equity for women and girls through research, education and advocacy. More than ever, we must embrace our values and continue to strive towards <u>diversity</u>, <u>equity and inclusion</u>; it's a journey that will never end.
