WHAT IT DOES WHY IT MATTERS



LEVELS THE PLAYING FIELD

Ensures 2026 mid-term elections are conducted fairly, protecting fair representation and preserving democratic norms.



IS TEMPORARY

Emergency maps expire in 2030. The California Redistricting Commission retains authority to draw congressional districts after the next census.



COMMITS TO FAIR REDISTRICTING

Reaffirms California's commitment to not diluting the voices of historically marginalized groups.



IS FAIR AND PROPORTIONAL

Changes ONLY occur if other states illegally redraw maps mid-decade to benefit an authoritarian agenda and advance Project 2025.



KEEPS POWER WITH THE VOTERS

The special election allows voters to decide what is in the best interest of Californians.
